

## **Reciprocal Facilities 2017**

Ascot	Free parking in either CP1 or CP2.
	Proceed to one of the Ticket Offices to collect an entry ticket on production of their relevant metal badge, this barcoded ticket will give admission into the racecourse.
	Once inside the racecourse please wear the racecourses relevant metal badge which will allow access to the King Edward VII Enclosure (Premier Admission).
	There is a dress code in the King Edward VII Enclosure.
Bangor on Dee	Access to the Paddock Enclosure. Free car parking (but not in Members Car Park)
Bath	Entry to course and car parking.
Brighton	Free parking in the public car park at the front of the course. Entry to both premier and grandstand & access to Silks Restaurant to buy lunch.
Carlisle	Entry to course and car parking only
Cartmel	General admission to both the Paddock and the Course enclosure and free parking in the overflow car parks. Parking inside the track is £6 per car per day on a first come first served basis.
Chepstow	Use of the members bar which is in the Tintern and St Arvans suite (2 <sup>nd</sup> floor premier Stand). A viewing box is also available – the number of which will be announced on the notice board in the members bar on the day.
Curragh	Admission to course and car parking. They are undergoing a major redevelopment so have no members facilities at present.
Doncaster	County access which includes the parade ring. Dress code of no denim, sportswear or trainers and gents must wear a collared shirt in this area.
	Guests can get admission to the Grandstand where there is no dress code
Epsom	Entry into public enclosures & free parking in car parks 3, 6 & 7.
Exeter	Access to the Haldon Premier stand as well as the Grandstand & Paddock. No formal dress code but smart/ casual attire preferred. Dress for the weather. Parking is free and is located in the centre of the course.
Ffos Las	Access to the annual members area & car parking.
Fontwell	Premier admission, grandstand & paddock. Free car parking on site. £5 for centre of course parking. Restaurant - £10 off per member.
Goodwood	Dress code in the Richmond Enclosure – jacket and tie for gentleman, no jeans, shorts or fancy dress. Members can park in No2 car park (members car park) which is free of charge.

Haydock	Access into the County Enclosure and free car parking.
	Dress code is smart casual, no trainers, track wear or fancy dress.
	No access into the Members bar due to limited space.
Huntingdon	Entry to course and free car parking
Kelso	Entry to course and free car parking
Kempton	Entry to course and free car parking

Lingfield	Access to course & free car parking
Ludlow	Premier admission with access to all public areas & free car parking postcode SY8 2BT. Smart/casual attire.
Market Rasen	Entry to course and car parking in the main car park.
	Dress code is smart casual, no ripped jeans, football tops or trainers. Men will need to wear a collar but this can be a nice polo shirt as ties are not required.
Musselburgh	Entry to course and free car parking
Newcastle	Entry to Premier enclosure & free car parking
Newmarket	Members MUST register at the Free Pass Office which is located:
	- July Course – Premier Entrance 2 (next to the first set of turnstiles).
	- Rowley Mile – Grandstand and Paddock Entrance (located next to the turnstiles, adjacent to the free car park)
	Access will be granted into the Premier Enclosure, but not into the annual badge holder's facilities or car park. Smart/casual dress code: No trainers, t-shirts, sports attire or extreme attire are permitted.
Newton Abbot	Car parking is in the centre of the course (disabled parking is nearside and not centre course). Access to both the Course and Paddock Enclosures. No strict dress code unless dining in our restaurants. Visiting members can use the Annual Members Lounge which is next door to the Owners and Trainers Bar if space permits on the day.
Plumpton	Entry to course and car parking. Free racecard on entry. No formal dress code.
Pontefract	Premier enclosure & free car parking. No use of Members bar.
Punchestown	Free parking in the main car park and access to all the bars in the grandstand and the parade ring enclosure.
Ripon	Access to the Club Enclosure.
Salisbury	Use of the Bibury enclosure and all of its facilities.
Sandown	Access to both our premier and grandstand enclosures. Parking is free in the

	centre of the course (More Lane entrance) or for £6 in our main front car park (Portsmouth Road). Dress code in the Premier enclosure is smart casual,
	gentlemen are required to wear a collared shirt, polo shirt or polo necked jumper and smart jeans are allowed. We encourage ladies to dress for a smart occasion, hats and fascinators are welcome but not essential. Shorts, trainers, sportswear, flip flops and ripped jeans are not permitted.
Sedgefield	Entry to the Grandstand & Paddock. Free car parking
Southwell	Entry to the Premier Enclosure on the 1st floor & car parking.
Stratford	Entry to course
Taunton	Access to Members Enclosure and free car parking
Thirsk	Park in Premier Car Park and access the racecourse through the Premier Entrance. Report to the desk on the left showing the Newbury Membership badge. Once inside the racecourse access to all facilities other than the Owners & Trainers Bar and our Annual Members Bar which unfortunately is not large enough to accommodate visitors. Dress code in the Premier of trousers or really smart jeans with shoes and a collared shirt.
Uttoxeter	Admission to Premier enclosure
Warwick	Free parking in the centre of the racecourse and entry to the course.
Wincanton	Use of the Annual members car park and access to the Annual Members Lounge situated on the ground floor adjacent to the Stalbridge Lounge.
Windsor	Free car parking. Entry into the Club Enclosure but no access to Members facilities.
Wolverhampton	Access to the Grandstand on the ground floor and to the Premier suite up on the 1st floor. Free parking.
Worcester	Entry to course & car parking plus use of the Croft Suite and the ground floor bar in the grandstand.
Yarmouth	Free parking in the general car park. Access into the Premier Enclosure.
